THE IDOLATRY OF MERE FORMALISM

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1 SAMUEL 3:21 ESV

And JEHOVAH appeared again at Shiloh, for JEHOVAH revealed himself to Samuel at Shiloh by the word of JEHOVAH. And the word of Samuel came to all Israel.

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JUDGES 13:1

And the people of Israel again did what was evil in the sight of the LORD, so the LORD gave them into the hand of the Philistines for forty years.

2 The Philistines drew up in line against Israel, and when the battle spread, Israel was defeated by the Philistines, who killed about four thousand men on the field of battle.

3 And when the troops came to the camp, the elders of Israel said, "Why has the LORD defeated us today before the Philistines? Let us bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD here from Shiloh, that it may come among us and save us from the power of our enemies."

4 So the people sent to Shiloh and brought from there the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, who is enthroned on the cherubim. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were there with the ark of the covenant of God.

1 SAMUEL 2:12, 17 ESV

12 Now the sons of Eli were worthless men. They did not know JEHOVAH. 17 Thus the sin of the young men was very great in the sight of JEHOVAH, for the men treated the offering of JEHOVAH with contempt.

With this sacred chest were associated the most wonderful revelations of God's truth and power. In former days miraculous victories had been achieved whenever it appeared. It was shadowed by the wings of the golden cherubim, and the unspeakable glory of the Shekinah, the visible symbol of the most high God, had rested over it in the holy of holies.

5 As soon as the ark of the covenant of the LORD came into the camp, all Israel gave a mighty shout, so that the earth resounded. 6 And when the Philistines heard the noise of the shouting, they said, "What does this great shouting in the camp of the Hebrews mean?"

And when they learned that the ark of the LORD had come to the camp, 7 the Philistines were afraid, for they said, "A god has come into the camp." And they said, "Woe to us! For nothing like this has happened before. 8 Woe to us! Who can deliver us from the power of these mighty gods? These are the gods who struck the Egyptians with every sort of plague in the wilderness.

9 Take courage, and be men, O Philistines, lest you become slaves to the Hebrews as they have been to you; be men and fight." 10 So the Philistines fought, and Israel was defeated, and they fled, every man to his home. And there was a very great slaughter, for there fell of Israel thirty thousand foot soldiers.

11 And the ark of God was captured, and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, died.

MORNING MANNA, P. 78.

How prone is man to trust for salvation in forms or rites or material symbols. ... They thought that if only the ark of God were brought to the battlefield, they would have victory. They forgot that the ark alone could not save them. It was only a symbol of a spiritual relationship. It was not the ark but God Himself who could save them.

There was no more power in the ark itself than in the idols of the heathen. Having the ark was useless unless the relationship with God which it symbolized, was what it should have been. Wearing a cross externally does not indicate that the meaning or message of the cross has transformed the life of the inner man.

MORNING MANNA, P. 78.

As Billy Sunday used to say, "Going into a church does not make you a Christian any more than going into a garage makes you an automobile." Merely going through the forms of religious service is not enough. God looks into the heart. It is the motive that counts. Saying prayers cannot take the place of praying.

They had not realized that their faith was only a nominal faith, and had lost its power to prevail with God. The law of God, contained in the ark, was also a symbol of His presence; but they had cast contempt upon the commandments, had despised their requirements, and had grieved the Spirit of the Lord from among them.

When the people obeyed the holy precepts, the Lord was with them to work for them by His infinite power; but when they looked upon the ark, and did not associate it with God, nor honor His revealed will by obedience to His law, it could avail them little more than a common box.

They looked to the ark as the idolatrous nations looked to their gods, as if it possessed in itself the elements of power and salvation. They transgressed the law it contained; for their very worship of the ark led to formalism, hypocrisy, and idolatry.
